Annual dues are used to pay for the quarterly newsletter and operational costs for meetings and special events. We also help fund local environmental projects.

Members are required to join the state organization, Illinois Audubon Society, which is not affiliated with the National Audubon Society. (In fact the national organization was founded several years after IAS.) Illinois Audubon supports a variety of environmental and conservation projects and maintains many wildlife sanctuaries throughout the state. IAS members receive a quarterly newsletter, Cardinal News, and a magazine, Illinois Audubon, to keep them apprised of IAS activities.
